

Medicaid/HMK Plus & HMK/CHIP Optometric Eyeglass Benefits

Children - includes age 20 and under

Items that are covered with a prescription that meets minimum criteria of refractive errors:

- Frames supplied by Classic Optical
- Lens styles of single vision, lined bifocals or lined trifocals
- Round bifocals
- Lens material of glass or plastic (glass takes longer to make)

Items that may be covered by MT Medicaid's or HMK's benefit plan as medically necessary and a Prior Authorization is requested by prescribing doctor (considered add-ons)

- Deluxe frames
- Photochromatic or transition material in lenses
- Progressive or no-line bifocals and trifocals
- Tints other than Rose 1 and 2
- Ultra violet and scratch resistant coatings
- Polycarbonate lens material (would be covered if member is monocular or blind in one eye
 with Prior Authorization request from prescribing doctor)
- High Index material for large refractive prescriptions
- Fresnel prism
