Effective February 1, 2020

Prior Authorization and Continued Stay Requirements for Substance Use Disorder Intensive Out Patient Services (ASAM2.1) Adult and Adolescent

Effective February 1, 2020, continued stay reviews will be required for all SUD bundled Intensive Outpatient services (ASAM 2.1) Adult and Adolescent as outlined in the current version of the Addictive and Mental Disorders Provider Manual for Substance Use Disorder and Adult Mental Health.

The transition of the Department's new Utilization Management contractor is complete, therefore the temporary hold on the above services will no longer be in effect beginning February 1, 2020. Mountain-Pacific Quality Health Foundation, in partnership with Telligen will be providing utilization management and review of behavioral health services covered through Montana Healthcare Programs provided by the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS).
