Vaccines for Children (VFC) Code Update

The Vaccines for Children (VFC) program provides selected vaccines available at no cost to providers for eligible children 18 years old and under. Children enrolled in Healthy Montana Kids (HMK) are not eligible for the VFC Program. [Please see the CDC website for updated dosages.](#)

The vaccines provided by VFC are:

Code	Description
90620	Meningococcal recombinant protein and outer membrane vesicle vaccine, serogroup B, 2-dose schedule, for intramuscular use. For more information call the VFC Program.
90621	Meningococcal recombinant lipoprotein vaccine, serogroup B, 3-dose schedule, for intramuscular use. For more information call the VFC Program.
90633	Hepatitis A vaccine, pediatric/adolescent dosage (2-dose schedule), for intramuscular use
90647	Hemophilus influenza B vaccine (Hib), PRP-OMP conjugate (3-dose schedule), for intramuscular use
90648	Hemophilus influenza B vaccine (Hib), PRP-T conjugate (4-dose schedule), for intramuscular use
90651	Human Papillomavirus vaccine types 6, 11, 16, 18, 31, 33, 45, 52, 58, nonavalent (HPV), 3-dose schedule, for intramuscular use
90670	Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine, polyvalent (13 valent), for intramuscular use
90672	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent, live (LAIV4), for intranasal use
90674	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), preservative free, .5mL dosage, for intramuscular use
90680	Rotavirus vaccine, pentavalent, 3-dose schedule, live for oral use
90681	Rotavirus vaccine, human, attenuated, 2-dose schedule, live for oral use
90685	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), split virus, preservative free, 0.25 mL dosage, for intramuscular use
90686	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), split virus, preservative free, 0.5 mL dosage, for intramuscular use
90687	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), split virus, 0.25 mL dosage, for intramuscular use
90688	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (IIV4), split virus, 0.5 mL dosage, for intramuscular use

Code	Description
90696	Diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, acellular pertussis vaccine, and poliovirus vaccine, inactivated (DTaP-IPV), children ages 4–6 years
90698	Diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, acellular pertussis vaccine, haemophilus influenza type B, and poliovirus vaccine (DTaP-Hib-IPV), inactivate, for intramuscular use
90700	Diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, and acellular pertussis vaccine (DTaP), for individuals younger than 7 years, for intramuscular use
90707	Measles, mumps and rubella virus vaccine (MMR), live, for subcutaneous use
90710	Measles, mumps, rubella, and varicella vaccine (MMRV), live, for subcutaneous use
90713	Poliovirus vaccine, inactivated (IPV)
90714	Tetanus and diphtheria toxoids (Td), preservative free, for individuals 7 years or older, for intramuscular use
90715	Tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap), for use in individuals 7 years or older, for intramuscular use
90716	Varicella virus vaccine, live, for subcutaneous use
90723	Diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, acellular pertussis vaccine, Hepatitis B, and poliovirus vaccine, inactivated (DTaP-HepB-IPV)
90732	Pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine, 23-valent, adult or immunosuppressed patient dosage, for individuals 2 years or older
90734	Meningococcal conjugate vaccine, serogroups A, C, Y, and W-135, quadrivalent (MCV4 or MenACWY), for intramuscular use
90744	Hepatitis B vaccine, pediatric/adolescent dosage (3-dose schedule), for intramuscular use
90756	Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (Cciiv4 vacc abx free), 0.5 mL dosage, for intramuscular use

Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) and Rural Health Clinics (RHC)

Vaccines and the administration of vaccines are not covered services in an RHC or FQHC setting and are not separately billable, except when provided to HMK-enrolled children.

Since HMK-enrolled children are not eligible for the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program, RHC and FQHC providers may bill Montana Medicaid for vaccines using revenue code 636 and the vaccine procedure code. If the vaccines were provided during a clinic encounter, the vaccines will be paid, and the administration fee(s) will bundle into the payable encounter. If a vaccine is administered without a clinic encounter FQHC and RHC providers may bill for the vaccine administration fee(s) using revenue code 771 and the vaccine administration procedure codes. Vaccine only encounters are not eligible for prospective payment system reimbursement.
