Family Contact Reminder for Home Support Services Providers

This provider notice serves to remind Mental Health Centers providing Home Support Services (HSS) of the requirements for family contact.

Per the Children's Mental Health Bureau Medicaid Services Provider Manual, HSS requires a minimum contact of two hours per week per family and includes bi-weekly (every other week) face-to-face contact with the family or caregiver.

Families that are unwilling or unable to participate in treatment and/or the services plan are ineligible to receive HSS. Providers who are unable to meet the family contact requirement for HSS may unbundle and select an appropriate procedure code to bill for services provided. When weekly service requirements are not met and services are unbundled, providers must document the reason the weekly service requirements were not met.
