FQHC, RHC, and Urban Indian Organization (UIO) Providers

Dual Eligible Members and Part B Preventive Vaccines Billing

The CY2025 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (PFS) Final Rule allows federally qualified health centers (FQHCs) and rural health clinics (RHCs) to bill and be paid for Part B preventive vaccines and their administration at the time of service.

Medicare payment to the provider will be higher and will decrease payment from Medicaid if vaccines are billed with an eligible visit. To prevent this, providers must bill Medicare separately for Part B preventive vaccines for dually eligible members.
