### Administrative Rules of Montana

- Administrative rules are agency regulations and standards used to implement, interpret, or set policy.
- Administrative rules are developed under a process outlined in the Montana Administrative Procedure Act.
- That Act requires state agencies to provide notice to the public when they wish to adopt, amend, or repeal administrative rule.
- The notices are compiled in the Montana Administrative Register (MAR).
- Once adopted, administrative rules are published in the Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM).




## ARM's continued

- Administrative Rules of Montana are one of the sources of regulation materials that Medicaid uses, along with Montana Code Annotated (MCA) and Code of Federal Regulations (CFR)
- Secretary of State has a new website they recently unveiled.

## ARMs for Medicaid

- It is the responsibility of the provider to be knowledgeable about sections of the Administrative Rules that relate to their provider type, provider policies and covered services.



# Montana Administrative Register

- Twice-monthly publication divided into three sections
- Proposal Notice Section:
  - This section contains state agencies proposed new, amended, or repealed rules; the rationale for the change; date and address of public hearing; and where written comments maybe submitted.
- Rule Adoption Section:
  - The section contains final rule notices which may show any changes made since the proposal state. All rule actions are effective the day after publication of the adoption notice unless otherwise specified in the final notice.
- Interpretation Section:
  - Contains the Attorney General's opinions and state declaratory rulings.
